
About the Endowments

Since 1994, this faculty-sponsored and administered endowment has provided 101 scholarships to outstanding undergraduate and graduate students. In 2005, the University received a generous contribution from the estate of Professor Jean Faurot, to add to the scholarships available to students. From the cumulative gifts of faculty and Professor Faurot, and through the investment of the endowments, the Faculty Senate was able to award at seven scholarships this past spring in the amount of a semester's tuition and fees.



Scholarship Recipients and Faculty

The endowments are invested by The University Foundation at Sacramento State, and average a 4-5% payout each year.



Together, the Faculty Endowment for Student Scholarships and the Jean & Louise Faurot Faculty Endowment, comprise over \$500,000 in endowed funds.

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship applications are received each fall semester by faculty nomination. This past year, seven awards were made from 116 undergraduate and graduate candidates.

Undergraduate Students

Completed at least one full year at Sacramento State.

Completed at least 60 units of course work, including at least 30 units at Sacramento State.

Enrolled at least half-time (six units) during the semester of application and have at least one semester remaining at Sacramento State.

Earned a 3.5 GPA or above, both overall and at Sacramento State, and be in the top 10% of GPAs in the student's major.

Post-Baccalaureate Students

Completed at least one semester at Sacramento State as a Post-Baccalaureate student.

Completed at least 12 units of course work.

Enrolled at least half-time (four units) during the semester of application and have at least one semester remaining at Sacramento State.

Earned a 3.5 GPA or above, both overall and at Sacramento State, and be in the top 5% of GPAs in the student's major.
