The Executive Committee adopted, on behalf of the Academic Senate, provisions for setting up the Professional Leave Committee for the 1983-84 academic year so that a committee

can be in place to begin the process as soon as possible. The composition of the Professional Leave Committee for 1983-84 shall consist of nine (9) members to include: one each from Business and Public Administration, Education, Engineering and Computer Science, Health and Human Services, and the Library, and four from Arts and Sciences. faculty eligible to serve on and to vote for the committee shall be in compliance with Article 27.5 of the Faculty Unit Agreement.

AS 83-64/AP, Ex. ACADEMIC CALENDARS - DEVELOPMENT GUIDELINES

The Academic Senate recommends the following guidelines. for the development of academic calendars:

- 1. That each semester be 15 weeks long. [Note: draft presented by Acting President Gerber, fall semester 1984 was 16 weeks long and spring semester 1985 was 14 weeks long.1
- That each fall semester end well before Christmas to allow grades to be turned in before the Christmas break.
- That if it becomes necessary to make adjustments to allow for the 12-week break between the end of spring semester and the beginning of fall semester, in order to accommodate summer session, these adjustments be made by beginning spring semester a week earlier rather than by beginning fall semester a week later.
- That in the future the Academic Policies Committee be presented with a complete calendar package for the year, including dates for summer sessions and winter and spring intersessions.
- That the Academic Policies Committee be advised as to any pertinent restrictions on the calendar caused by pay periods, problems in overlapping between regular semesters and summer sessions, etc.
