Page 2, section 4, add the sentence: The Dean may provide to the PLC an assessment of the quality of each proposal.

AS 84-39C/Ex. PROFESSIONAL LEAVES - CRITERIA AND PROCESS

The Academic Senate approves amendment of the Professional Leave Policy draft dated September 13, 1984, as follows:

Page 4, replace section on Difference in Pay (DIP)
Applications with the following: "Faculty members
eligible for Difference in Pay leaves shall submit
applications to the PLC on the forms provided. Deans and
departments will submit to the PLC assessment of the
impact of proposed leaves on curriculum and programs. The
PLC will forward to the Provost all Difference in Pay
proposals which meet minimal quality standards. Deadlines
for Difference in Pay applications shall be flexible; it
shall be campus practice to grant Difference in Pay leaves
whenever possible in the interests of faculty members,
departments, and schools. Sabbatical leave applications
that have been recommended by the PLC shall also be
considered to have been recommended for Difference in Pay
leaves if requested."

Carried unanimously.

AS 84-39/Ex., Flr. PROFESSIONAL LEAVES - CRITERIA AND PROCESS

The Academic Senate postpones further debate on AS 84-39, Professional Leaves - Criteria and Process, until the October 10, 1984, Academic Senate meeting and asks the Executive Committee to discuss this issue with the administration in an effort to reach agreement.
