[The Executive Committee is elected by and from the faculty members of the Academic Senate. See list of faculty Senators on back of this agenda.]

Bylaws of the Academic Senate, California State University, Sacramento, Article I:

"G. The first organizational meeting shall be for the purpose of nominating candidates for the Executive Committee of the new Academic Senate. The Senate first shall nominate candidates for the office of Chair and Vice Chair. Nominations shall be from the floor; self-nominations are permitted. If there are more than two candidates for either office, there shall be a secret ballot, with each Senator voting for one candidate for each office to reduce the number of candidates for each office to two. The two candidates for each office receiving the largest number of votes are the final nominees for Chair and Vice Chair.

"The Senate then shall nominate candidates for the remaining positions on the Executive Committee. Nominations shall be from the floor; self-nominations are permitted. If the number of candidates exceeds eight, there shall be a secret ballot to reduce the number of candidates to eight; each Senator may vote for eight candidates. The eight candidates with the largest number of votes are the nominees for the Executive Committee. In case of ties the number of nominees shall be increased to include the tied candidates."
