### AREA B. THE PHYSICAL UNIVERSE AND ITS LIFE FORMS

(12 units)

- B1. Physical Science (3 units minimum)
- B2. Life Science (3 units minimum)
- B3. Laboratory Requirement

At least one course with a laboratory component must be taken in B1 or B2.

- B4. Quantitative Reasoning (3 units minimum)

### AREA C. THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES

(12 units)

- C1. World Civilizations (3 units)
- C2. Arts, Humanities, and Foreign Languages (9 units)

Note: The twelve (12) units taken in Area C must be taken from at least two different subject designations.

**AREA D. THE INDIVIDUAL AND SOCIETY (15 units)**

D1. Foundations in Social Sciences (3-6 units)

D2. Major Social Issues of the Contemporary Era (3 units)

Note: The nine (9) units taken in Areas D1 and D2 must be taken in at least two different subject designations.

D3. American Institutions (6 units)

Note: If American Institutions is satisfied by examination, additional units must be taken in the other subareas of Area D to total 15 units.

**AREA E. UNDERSTANDING PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT (3 units)**

**OTHER PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:**

1. **Upper Division Units:** At least nine units taken to complete the General Education requirement must be upper division.
2. **Advanced Study:** At least three of the nine units of upper division coursework must be in courses specially designed as Advanced Study. Prerequisites for enrollment in Advanced Study courses are completion of Area A2 (Written Communication), Area A3 (Critical Thinking), completion of 56 units either prior to or during the semester the Advanced Study course is taken, and a passing score on the Writing Proficiency Exam.

Note 1: All courses in Area A must include a library component.

Note 2: Students must enroll in a written communications course (English 1A or equivalent), or an appropriate preparation course as determined by the EPT, during their first semester of enrollment at CSUS.

Note 3: Students must complete all requirements in Area A prior to enrollment in upper division courses in G.E.

**AREA B. THE PHYSICAL UNIVERSE AND ITS LIFE FORMS** (12 units)

- B1. Physical Sciences (3 units minimum)  
Note: All courses must include a laboratory.
- B2. Life Sciences (3 units minimum)  
Note: All courses must include a laboratory.
- B3. Quantitative Reasoning (3 units minimum)  
Note: Students must enroll in a quantitative reasoning course, or an appropriate preparation course as determined by the ELM, during their first semester of enrollment at CSUS.
- B4. Further Studies in the Natural Sciences or Quantitative Reasoning (3 units)

Courses from this subarea, or additional courses from subareas B1, B2, or B3, to complete the 12-unit requirement for Area B.

**AREA C. THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES** (12 units)

- C1. World Cultures--Historical Perspectives (3 units)
- C2. Introductory Studies in the Arts (3 units minimum)  
Note: Lower division courses only; only includes courses offered by disciplines in the arts.
- C3. Introductory Studies in the Humanities (3 units minimum)  
Note: Lower division courses only; only includes courses offered by disciplines in the humanities.
- C4. Further Studies in the Arts and Humanities (3 units)

Courses from this subarea, or additional courses from subareas C2 or C3, to complete the 12-unit requirement in Area C.

**AREA D. THE INDIVIDUAL AND SOCIETY (12 units)****D1. Foundations of the Social Sciences (6 units)**

Two 3-unit courses in different social science disciplines.

Note: Lower division courses only; only one course may be listed by each of the several science disciplines.

**D2. World Cultures--Contemporary Perspectives (3 units)****D3. Major Social Issues (3 units)****AREA E. UNDERSTANDING PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT (3 units)**

Note: All lower division courses, except for some quantitative reasoning and performance courses, must include some writing and all upper division courses must include writing as a significant element.

**OTHER PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Upper Division Units:** At least nine units taken to complete the General Education requirement must be upper division. Enrollment in upper division courses requires completion of Area A coursework and second semester sophomore or higher standing.
- 2. Advanced Study:** At least three of the nine units of upper division coursework must be in courses specially designed as Advanced Study. Prerequisites for enrollment in Advanced Study courses are completion of Area A, completion of 56 units either prior to or during the semester the Advanced Study course is taken, and a passing score on the Writing Proficiency Exam.
- 3. Perspectives of Women and Minorities (3-6 units):** At least 3(6) units of coursework taken to complete G.E. requirements must be in courses that also satisfy criteria for this supervening requirement.

Note: In addition to satisfying G.E. requirements, the student must satisfy Title 5, Section 40404, requirements (American Institutions) by examination or by completion of approved coursework (6 units).
