The Academic Senate rescinds AS 89-73, G.E. Program Revision.

The Academic Senate endorses, in principle, GERT's recommendation that the administrative position with responsibility for G.E. be redefined in such a way as to provide that 1) administration of the G.E. program constitutes the bulk of the position's time and 2) the position is assigned the appropriate degree of responsibility and authority over the full range of academic administrative tasks related to

administration of the program (pages 16-17, 49-51). The Academic Senate requests that the Academic Vice President confer with the Dean of Arts and Sciences and other school deans concerning alternative models for administration of G.E., and that proposed models be presented to the Senate by October 1, 1989, for discussion and recommendation to the President.
