\*AS 91-11/Ex., FPDC GRADUATE STUDIES AND RESEARCH AND SPONSORED PROJECTS, PROGRAMS AND FUNCTIONS OF OFFICES

[Responds to ad hoc Committee on Scholarship recommendation (Attachment B, February 14, 1991, Academic Senate Agenda Addendum)]

The Academic Senate is concerned about the proposed Whereas, merger of the Office of Graduate Studies and the Office of Research and Sponsored Projects in relation to how the merger would provide adequate support for the continuation of current programs and functions; and, furthermore,

The Academic Senate is concerned that a merger at Whereas, this time and creation of a new position description may, de facto, define relative priorities and policy direction for graduate programs and research and sponsored projects at CSU, Sacramento. Such definition, prior to the Senate's consideration of written recommendations from the Faculty Professional Development Committee, the Research and Creative Activity Committee, the Graduate Policies and Programs Comittee and the ad hoc Committee on Scholarship would be premature; therefore, be it

Each of these committees would submit a written Resolved, report on its findings relative to the proposed consolidation of the two offices to the Senate by March 1, 1991; and, be it further

The Academic Senate recommends that, if the offices Resolved, are merged, priorities, functions and definitions of programs currently supported by the offices be maintained and that no permanent appointment to any newly created administrative position be made until the Senate has had the opportunity to act on the recommendations of the Faculty Professional Development Committee, the Research and Creative Activity Committee, the Graduate Policies and Programs Committee, and the ad hoc Committee on Scholarship; and, be it further

The Academic Senate requests that the President Resolved, provide an explanation of how the proposed merger, or any other administrative changes related to the Offices of Graduate Studies and Research and

Sponsored Projects, will accomplish a savings and how the programmatic concerns identified by the relevant committees will be addressed.
