*FS 99-44/CPC, Ex. PROGRAM CHANGE PROPOSALS

The Faculty Senate recommends approval of the following program change proposals:

- a. Bachelor of Science in Computer Science:
 - 1) Add CSc28 (Discrete Structures for Computer Science) as degree requirement.
 - 2) Add CSc28 (Discrete Structures for Computer Science) as prerequisite to upper division courses CSc 130, 132, and 137.
 - CSc28 replaces Math Elective in degree requirement--keeping total units required the same.

b. Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy:

Add: Concentration in Logic and Philosophy of Science. Concentration in Applied Ethics and Law.

c. Graduate Liberal Arts Program:

MA in Liberal Arts: Concentration in Theatre Arts

d. Department of Foreign Languages--Minor in French:

Revision of core requirements to require 12 upper division units taught in French and require students to meet with a Minor advisor for course selection.

e. Master of Science in Electrical and Electronic Engineering:

- 1) Require students to have a program of student evaluated and approved by a professor in Electrical and Electronic Engineering.
- 2) Add a 3-unit numerical analysis course to the required core.
- 3) Merge the current six areas of elective fields of study into four areas.
- 4) Offer a comprehensive exam (Plan C) as an option to the culminating experience.

f. Special Education Credential Programs:

- Add Level II Specialist Credential training program in Mild/Moderate and Moderate/Severe as required by Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations.
- 2) Add Level I Early Childhood Special Education Specialist teacher preparation program to meet new California standards.
- g. Master of Arts in Psychology:

Add: Concentration in Industrial Organization Psychology.

h. Master of Arts in Communication Studies:

Add: "Instructional Communication" as a major area of study.
