2. Open Forum

Folsom Hall Connectivity (Rich)

Network connections die spontaneously. This seems to apply to both wireless and hard-wired Ethernet. This is most pronounced when lots of students sign on to take exams. The faculty have responded to this problem by scheduling some of these exams very early in the morning, when there is less digital traffic. Christine will investigate.

The new Printsmart printer is up and running.

Refresh (Binod)

The Faculty/staff computer refresh will go forward (it was previously put on hold). There was discussion about how this is funded, and at what level. Basically Academic Affairs provides a certain amount of funds per machine to be replaced. IRT handles the purchasing. If a college decides they want something more than the very basic allocation per machine, the college must find the money from their own budget. Lisa pointed out that, at least in the case of NSM, the basic allocation does not cover the cost of a basic machine, i.e., the college has to supplement every computer purchase.

Rewiring of Eureka Hall (Binod)

IRT has done a great job of rewiring Eureka Hall.
