### FS 13/14-73/GE/GRPC/EX General Education Area D Learning Outcomes, Revision

The Faculty Senate recommends revising the "General Education Area D Learning goals and Outcomes" (<a href="http://www.csus.edu/acaf/ge/geareacriteria.html">http://www.csus.edu/acaf/ge/geareacriteria.html</a>)

Rationale: The regularly scheduled review and revision process called for in the Sacramento State GE Policy typically occurs in each area every 5 years. The review and revision process was placed on hold for several years pending the review and revision of the Baccalaureate Learning Goals, completed in 2009. The review and revision process resumed in 2011 with Area B and Faculty have now moved on to reviewing Area D. Faculty spent more than three semesters discussing and reviewing Area D Learning Outcomes. These revised Learning Outcomes will provide students with opportunities to clearly demonstrate their knowledge, skills and understandings, and will provide a coherent set of outcomes to permit GE program assessment.
