<b>Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification.</b> The current Art History minor is unstructured, specifying only that 21 units be taken in Art History of which nine units must be upper-division. It also lacks a "minimum grade," like the two other minors in Art (Art Education, Studio Art). The purpose of this proposal is to clarify the requirements in the Art History minor by listing the specific lower division Art History courses that may be used. It also is intended to bring the minimum grade requirements for all Art minors into conformity with the minimum grade requirement in the Art major.  <b>Note:</b> This proposal replaces one that was submitted in March 2012 but was stalled in committee at the College level because the side-by-side document was not attached. In the meantime, the creation of ART 1C has changed the situation, resulting in the present solution.

Units required for Minor: 21, including 9 lower division units in Art Studio, 3 lower division units in Art History, and 9 units of Art Education selected with the approval of the Art Education Credential Advisor.

Units required for Minor: 21 with all units of which must be taken in Art History; a minimum of 9 units must be in upper division.

**Requirements – Minor – Art Education**

Units required for Minor: 21, including 9 lower division units in Art Studio, 3 lower division units in Art History, and 9 units of Art Education selected with the approval of the Art Education Credential Advisor. A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses applied to the Minor in Art Education.

**Requirements – Minor – Art History**

Units required for Art History Minor: 21, all of which must be taken in Art History. Students are strongly encouraged to select the four lower division courses and three upper division courses in consultation with an Art History faculty advisor. A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses applied to the Minor in Art History.
