The Senate debated a motion to not remove the aspects of the policy requiring "ranking". After extensive debate the motion was not agreed to (Y=18, N=20).

Next a substitute motion was introduced from the floor to eliminate the IPP. During that discussion another motion to postpone any discussion of the IPP policy was made, seconded, discussed and not agreed to. The Senate continued to perfect FS 13/14-42/EX and FS 13/14-42a/FL (see below) until the time of adjournment.
