- ii. Group 2 – Areas B & E (Robin, Sujatha, Cynthia, and Farshid)
 - 1. CSC 135 – Computing Theory and Programming Languages
 - a. *Conditionally Approved* – syllabus needs to reflect A, B, C rubric, syllabus needs to clarify how 1,500 words is reached, and the Area B5 learning outcomes must be on the syllabus verbatim
 - 2. NURS 120 – Nursing Application of Research and Critical Analysis
 - a. *Revise and Resubmit* – lacking evidence of Quantitative Reasoning specially in Section 2 (page 3) – needs to specify which assignments meet this requirement as it is not clear in the syllabus; lack of mathematical analysis in assignments (only 2 weeks shown) – needs to further show all analysis done in course; the Area B5 outcomes need to be on the syllabus verbatim; readings do not appear to be mathematical/research based; research elements of course need to be further explained – suggested to attach example assignments
 - 3. NURS 173 – Theoretical Foundations for Leadership and Management
 - a. *Rejected* – 6 unit courses cannot be General Education; as stated in EO 1100 students cannot exceed 12 units of coursework for Area B in General Education
- iii. Group 3 – Area D (Cristina, Stephanie, Bridget, Michael, and Anna)
 - 1. NURS 160 – Human Sexuality
 - a. *Conditionally Approved* – the Area D learning outcomes must be on the syllabus verbatim
 - 2. PSYC 135 – Psychology of Multicultural Groups
 - a. *Conditionally Approved* – the Area D learning outcomes must be on the syllabus verbatim
 - 3. PSYC 137 – Stress Management
 - a. *Conditionally Approved* – the Area D learning outcomes must be on the syllabus verbatim
