3. From the Chair

- ASCSU Chair Guerin called on campuses for input on three First Reading Resolutions under discussion by the CSU Academic Senate: Emeritus Status, Representative Elections, and Adoption of the Common Core Language. The Executive Committee in consultation with the Sacramento State Academic Senators (*Krabacher, Miller, and Holl*) referred each of the items to relevant Senate Committees for feedback by March 13 (*FPC Emeritus Status, EXEC: Representative Elections, and CPC and GE/GRPC: Adoption of the Common Core*). The items will also be placed on the Feb 13 Senate agenda as Information. The Chair will update the Senate and asked that faculty wishing to provide additional feedback may do so prior to March 13 by sending it to Senator Miller (cmiller@csus.edu).
- 4. **From the Provost:** Harmsen reported that the campus will undertake three searches: Dean of the College of Engineering and Computer Science, Dean of the College of Social Sciences and Interdisciplinary Studies, and a Vice Provost. All searches will be nationwide.

The Dean's Searches will be undertaken immediately and will be concluded by the first week in May in order to have the new Deans in place by the beginning of Fall 2014. An external firm will be hired to assist with the recruitment of a pool of eligible candidates for the Dean of Engineering and Computer Science. The draft timelines for the Dean searches will be shared with Exec at the Feb 18 meeting.

5. <u>Academic Resource Allocation Taskforce Call</u>: The call was reviewed and will be sent out. The Chair will make an announcement at the Feb 13 Senate meeting.

6. **FPC – Proposed AY Calendars for 2015-16 and 2016-17**

- Area D Learning Outcomes: Exec reviewed the proposed amendment that was at First Reading and a motion was made, seconded, and carried to amend the language of #3. to: Demonstrate and understanding of the role of human diversity in human society, for example, race, ethnicity, class, age, ability/disability, sexual identity, gender and gender expression. The resolution will be updated and the Senate will be advised.
